

CHAPTER 12

The Most Abused Scriptures in the Bible: Malachi 3:8-11

Many Scriptures are twisted to promote the aims of false teachers, but none so consistently and vigorously as Malachi 3:8-11:

⁸Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings.

⁹You are cursed with a curse, for you have robbed Me, even this whole nation.

¹⁰Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house. And try Me now in this, says the Lord of hosts, If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.

¹¹And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, so that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field, says the Lord of hosts.

The above four Old Testament Scriptures have been masterfully corrupted by Satan to pervert the gospel, to introduce a false Christ, and to curse those whom God has blessed. Furthermore, preachers use
